

Ten Words for a Faithful Life: Becoming a Priest in God's Kingdom
(Overview – Ex 19 & 20 – 06-28-20am)

Central thought: When think about 10 commandments, think first about character of God

I. Structure Think: Loving God; Loving your Neighbor

A. Loving God (1st four commandments)

B. Loving Others (2nd six commandments)

II. Relevance

A. Learning about the Law from the Old Testament

Two Great Commandments (Deut 6.5; Lev 19.18)

Ten Commandments (Exod 20; cf. Deut 5)

600+ laws (throughout remainder of Pentateuch)

B. Living with the Law in the New Testament

1. The Law is still in God's word (Matt 5.18; Jn 10.35; Rom 15.4; 2 Tim 3.16-17)

2. Jesus said The Law still matters (Matt 5.17)

3. Our relationship with God is supreme over every other relationship

4. The Law stands as a constant reminder of our need for the gospel

III. Takeaway 4 statements:

1. God still uses His word to free those who are in slavery to sin.

2. God still uses His word to declare His sovereignty.

3. God still uses His word to reveal His love for all who place their faith in His Son.

4. God still offers covenant promises & covenant expectations for those whom He saves.
